Until 12/31/2017 you can buy a Brand New 2017 LEAF for \$15,000!!! Nissan is making deals with local Power Utility companies because the 2018 LEAF will be different than the 2011 through 2017 model and have more range and so they are trying to sell off their stock.

Here is the flyer you need to bring to a dealer with your PSEG Bill to save \$10,000 (other utility companies are involved as well, search Google for your Electric Company name and Nissan LEAF)

In NJ there is NO Sales Tax for 100% Electric Car - That saves you another \$2000

There is also a Federal Tax Incentive that is based on your income tax. If you have paid at least \$7500 in Federal Income Tax your tax professional can fill out the forms so you can claim the \$7500 towards your taxes. If you have paid all your taxes and you don't owe anything you will get a check from the IRS.

If you owe \$10,000 then the forms will deduct \$7500 from what you owe.

**Claiming the Credit**

Fill out Form 8936 [↗](#), Qualified Plug-in Electric Drive Motor Vehicle Credit.

For vehicles acquired for personal use, report the credit from Form 8936 [↗](#) on the appropriate line of your Form 1040, U.S. Individual Income Tax Return [↗](#).

For vehicles purchased in 2010 or later, this credit can be used toward the alternative minimum tax (AMT).

If the qualifying vehicle is purchased for business use, the credit for the business use of an electric vehicle is reported on Form 3800 [↗](#), General Business Credit.

**Additional Information**

Just so you know the 2018 LEAF will get 150 miles range but the lowest you can get it is \$22,499

The 2019 is supposed to get 220 miles range per charge. But we do not have a price yet.
